- All British Rowing Racing Licences (or equivalent for non-BR competitors) will be checked on the day.
- The Masters Handicap System will be used, where appropriate, as detailed in the 2011 British Rowing Almanack.

- Silver medals will be awarded if there are 4 or more entries in an event, bronze medals if there are 8 or more entries.
