

North London Competition Manager “Rowshows” 2010.

From January to March 2010, the North London Competition Managers delivered a series of “Rowshows” across the North London Boroughs of Barnet, Enfield, Haringey and Waltham Forest.

The “Rowshows” were the start of a pathway of opportunity. Each pupil had the opportunity to compete in;

- An intra-school competition, which led to;
- A virtual inter-school borough league, which was followed by exit routes of;
- A borough championships delivered two weeks after the Rowshows, from which teams were selected to represent the borough in;
- The London Youth Games.
- The National Junior Indoor Rowing Championships and the activity of London Youth Rowing.

37 schools participated; 8 in Waltham Forest, 10 in Barnet, 10 in Enfield and 9 in Haringey.

4240 Pupils participated in the competition, 833 in Waltham Forest, 1106 in Barnet, 1308 in Enfield, 1093 in Haringey

1209 of these pupils were new to inter-school competition.
